Makin Metal Powders Selects Clearfield for its First US Manufacturing Operation

Makin Metal Powders Ltd., a United Kingdom-based manufacturer of metal powders, selected Pennsylvania as the location for its first manufacturing operation in North America. The new, 75,000 square-foot facility will be in the Clearfield Commerce Park in Lawrence Township. Makin Metal Powders plans to invest nearly \$10 million into the project and is expected to create at least 40 manufacturing jobs at the time of startup.

Mr. Swales stated that Makin Metal Powders evaluated several states for the potential new location, but ultimately decided to locate to Pennsylvania due to the strength of its manufacturing sector and workforce, and its prime location to proximity markets.

Jonathan Hood, managing director at Makin stated "We are very excited to be expanding our operations into the US because many customers throughout the Americas have been urging us to take this step so that we can further build on our already excellent reputation for service and value, and support them from a 'local' base." "When searching for the right location we were blessed with a choice of several very fine options, but the inward investment teams in Clearfield and Pennsylvania impressed us with their blend of knowledge, professionalism and friendliness. This, coupled with a great plot right in the heart of the US powder metallurgy industry, meant the choice was second to none. We look forward to joining and contributing to the local community and to serving our customers on the US side of the pond."

Makin Metal Powders Ltd. is a UK-based producer of non-ferrous metals powders. The company supplies a global customer base with applications in many different industries. Its products are used primarily within the automotive and engineering industry, with a combination of powder metallurgy parts and friction material applications, which accounts for 80 percent of its production activities.

Mr. Swales said it was a lengthy site selection process for Clearly Ahead, which partnered with the state's Office of International Business Development and took about 18 months to reach an agreement. Makin Metal Powders anticipates construction to commence in the Spring of 2020.

Riverfront Development Planned for Downtown Clearfield

The project known as River's Landing, will be located at the former Tool Shed site on Market Street neighboring the Riverwalk. Plans are to construct a two-story facility featuring on-site parking with 5,000 square feet on each floor designed for multiple tenants. The structure will have a modern, rustic feel that will mix well with the rest of the riverfront design concept to welcome guest traffic from vehicle, bicycle, canoe/kayak and passersby from the Riverwalk for a wonderful experience along the river and downtown Clearfield. Large windows and all-glass overhead doors will invite visitors to a view of the river. The land development plan highlights outdoor seating for a more open-air experience. The first floor will house an anchor tenant, possibly a family restaurant, that will provide a welcoming and festive environment. Outside seating and a second-floor event space overlook the Susquehanna River, Riverwalk and two local parks.


"Rather than a traditional masonry-style of downtown buildings, we opted for a warm and welcoming architectural style that bodes well with the Pennsylvania Wilds design guidelines and natural heritage of Clearfield and the Susquehanna River," Rob Swales commented. Initially the first floor areas will be a shell, Mr. Swales said, as tenants are secured, the spaces will be customized with the tenants' needs in mind. The second floor will have multi-office spaces with a larger conference room that can be used for training sessions and special events. The conference room area layout pairs well for in-house catering services from first floor occupants to accommodate special events. The second floor will feature a balcony overlooking the river. "As the developer of this project, Clearly Ahead intends to use products manufactured in Clearfield County," Mr. Swales said. This may include stone, brick, flooring, logs, and steel cable rail systems that are truly manufactured by local companies in Clearfield County. Mr. Swales stated "We want to instill community pride into the building and support our local vendors, manufactures, contractors and service providers as much as possible. We look forward to the opportunity to showcase 'Made in Clearfield County, PA' products in this development project." Mr. Swales anticipates construction will take 12 months with an anticipated start date of Spring 2020. The project will also include additional parking and sidewalk along the West Branch of the Susquehanna River from Lower Witmer Park to Market Street. The sidewalk will follow along the river and along Market Square building to pull together with the existing Riverwalk and River's Landing building in what is hoped to be a hub of activity. Over 100 parking spaces will be created among River's Landing and Market Square near Lower Witmer Park.

Clearfield County Industrial Development Authority Revolving Loan Fund Program

Loans of up to \$100,000 can be used for any manufacturing, industrial, commercial, educational or warehousing companies located in Clearfield County. Terms on the loans will vary with the type of use. Businesses must contribute 10% of the money to the project themselves. Local manufacturers have used these funds to purchase new equipment, to expand or renovate and other efforts to help them grow.

The process of applying for a loan is similar to those of the local banks with three years of financial records submitted with the application. Depending on the project, it should also include sales agreements, proposals and a business plan.
